



## Rate Class 57

3 Phase Schools, Public Infrastructure (water, sewer)

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### Availability

Available for three phase School and Public Infrastructure services. Subject to the established rules and regulations of LYREC.

### Type of Service

Three phase at available secondary voltages. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of 7.5 horsepower must be three phase, except with the approval of LYREC.

### Facility Charge

The minimum monthly facility charge under the above rate shall be \$50.00 or greater for all members per established rules and line extension policies.

### Rate Demand Charge

All kilowatts of billing demand per month at \$9.00 per kW.

### Energy Charge

All kWh @ 7.4¢

### Cost of Purchased Power Adjustment

If at any time after January 1, 2017 the wholesale cost of purchased power is increased or decreased, LYREC may increase or decrease the selling cost .1 mill for every .1 mill, or major fraction thereof, the cost of purchased power is increased or decreased.

### Capacity Minimum Charge

The monthly capacity charge will be \$1 per transformer kVA required by member's demand usage or member's requested kVA size, whichever is larger. Payment of capacity charge shall entitle the member in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt hours corresponding to the capacity charge in accordance with the foregoing rate.

### Determining of Billing Demand


The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the member for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which bill is rendered as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor. At the option of LYREC, the demand for motor loads may be established by using the name plate HP rating of the motor times a factor of .75 in lieu of metered demand.

### Power Factor Adjustment

The member agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges may be adjusted for members with 20 KW or more of measured demand to correct for average power factors lower than 90% and may be so adjusted for other members if and when LYREC deems necessary. Such adjustment will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% for each 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.
