POLICY BULLETIN NO. 701

SUBJECT:

Right of Way Easements.

POLICY:

Recorded right-of-way easements for the erection and maintenance of power lines are necessary to protect the Cooperative from financial loss in the event of the sale of land, or the relocation of highways and other public utilities which necessitate the relocation of LYREC lines.

The manager of this cooperative will have all easements now held by the cooperative recorded with the Clerk & Recorder of the County in which the easement is located.

The manager shall refuse to relocate poles and lines and/or to construct new lines for the benefit of a landowner until the landowner(s) of the property executes an easement in favor of the Cooperative.
